

References

Each use of arguments, thoughts or knowledge of others, literal quoting or paraphrasing should be marked with reference number in the text and the references should be listed in the bibliography at the end of the manuscript.

In-text citations should be numbered sequentially. The numbers should appear in brackets, each referring to a single source.

With multiple references to the same source, the number that has already been used should be repeated.

In the case that a text segment is supported by multiple citations, numbers should be separated by commas, *example* (3,4,6) or a hyphen where the citations follow sequentially, *example* (4-7).

Citing sources

All sources referred to in the article should be specified in the List of References at the end of the manuscript. Sources should be listed in accordance with the Vancouver style – “*Uniform Requirements for Manuscripts Submitted to Biomedical Journals*”. This style is supported by all reference management tools (e.g. EndNote, Medeley, Zotero). Full instructions are available on the website:

It is important that:

- the literature is listed by sequential numbers of cited sources;
- journal titles are abbreviated according to the Medline style:

- authors are specified by their last name and first name initial;
- the first six authors are specified; in the case that there are more than six, the 6th one is followed by “et al.” (*example 1*),
- the editors are given in the language of publication: “ur.” in Slovenian and “ed.” or “eds.” in English (*example 3*),
- a multi-part edition is specified in the language of publication: “*Vol. 1*” (*example 4*),
- preposition “In:” introduces information about the publication (author(s) or editor(s) and the book title) where a chapter of a publication is given (*example 5*) or a contribution from the proceedings of a conference (*example 6*);
- bachelor’s, master’s and doctoral theses are given in square brackets: »[*PhD Thesis*]« or »[*Master's Thesis*]« or »[*Thesis*]« (*example 7*),
- abbreviation “p”, which stands for Latin word “pagina” – page, defines the page of publication from which the content, idea or knowledge has been summarised (*examples 3–7*). This rule does not apply to articles (*examples 1 and 2*),
- in a web source, the date of access is given in square brackets. This is followed by an URL, which is introduced by the phrase “Available from:” (*example 8*).
